Research Analysis

The policy committee recommendation to HB 3903 requires law enforcement to prepare a written domestic violence incident report of each reported incident of domestic abuse. A dispatch log, call-for-service entry, or similar notation does not satisfy the written incident report requirement. The clerk of the district court is to accept for filing, file-stamp, and docket each petition for a protective order when presented. The petition and any attachments submitted shall be maintained as part of the case record, subject to confidentiality, redaction, sealing, or expungement. The measure requires members of the judiciary who hear criminal, juvenile, family, and domestic cases to complete no fewer than 2 hours of domestic violence training each year.
