Research Analysis

HB 3904, as introduced, requires the Oklahoma Medicaid Program to reimburse for depression screening during pregnancy and the postpartum period. OHCA must apply for any federal waiver, state plan amendment, or other authority needed for implementation. The Oklahoma Medicaid Program must also reimburse for prenatal, delivery, and postpartum services in lieu of a global payment for maternity services. The measure requires the Oklahoma Medicaid Program to make presumptive eligibility determination for pregnant women applying to the program and allow prenatal care to be delivered while the full application is waiting to be processed. The measure also requires the Oklahoma Medicaid Program to provide coverage and reimbursement for self-measurement blood pressure monitoring services for pregnant and postpartum women. The measure requires the Oklahoma Medicaid Program to reimburse for medically necessary remote ultrasound procedures as long as the health care providers uses certain digital technology. The Oklahoma Medicaid Program must reimburse for home visitation services when they are provided by doulas, community health workers, and other qualified personnel.
