Research Analysis

HB 3914 as introduced, prohibits state agencies or political subdivisions from expending any funds or taking any actions that violate a person's rights under the U. S. Constitution or federal law. State agencies and political subdivisions are also prohibited from assisting entities in expending any funds or taking any actions that violate a person's rights under the U. S. Constitution or federal law. State agencies are prohibited from collecting, retaining, or disclosing pregnancy-related data or religious affiliation information for the purpose of federal enforcement and any intergovernmental agreement requiring such data is null and void.

Additionally, the measure requires the Attorney General to provide legal defense for Oklahoma residents targeted by unconstitutional federal actions and to produce an annual report listing requests for legal defense for such reasons. *Unconstitutional federal actions* is defined in the measure as mass surveillance, data collection on pregnancies, religious registries, or raids on houses of worship, schools or hospitals.
