Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 3919 allows a board of county commissioners to establish, by vote, a five-member board of directors for the free fair association who are elected for a term of three years. Five-member boards are to function and be subject to the same requirements as nine-member boards. One board member must be elected from each county commissioner district and the remaining two board members must be elected from the county at large.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 3919 permits the board of county commissioners to vote for a certain five-member board of directors. The measure deals exclusively with county level voting procedures and board structure. The measure does not appropriate funds, increase administrative workload, or alter revenue sources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
