**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3928 establishes minimum payment standards for vision benefit plans when reimbursing licensed optometrists.

According to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA), this measure will impact managed care capitation payments under the state Medicaid plan, while having only a minimal impact on the state's HealthChoice plan. The Medicaid state share is estimated at \$1,320,743. Using managed care encounter data, OHCA calculated the difference between 100% of the Medicare rate and the allowable amount paid on claims, then adjusted to account for managed care factors that typically inflate capitation rates.

Therefore, the fiscal impact on the state budget is estimated at \$1,320,743.
