Research Analysis

HB 3982 directs Service Oklahoma to issue a non-resident in-transit temporary credential in lieu of a license plate for vehicles that are purchased in Oklahoma but are to be titled or registered in a jurisdiction other than Oklahoma.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3982 amends the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act to require Service Oklahoma to issue a non-resident in-transit temporary credential in lieu of a standard license plate for certain vehicles to be titled or registered outside Oklahoma. This change modifies existing credential issuance processes but does not authorize new appropriations, require additional staffing, or alter revenue sources. Although the bill could reduce the number of physical license plates issued, any associated cost avoidance is dependent on volume and contract terms and cannot be reliably estimated. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
