**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 4055 allows the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF) to increase fees for commercial pet breeders, non-commercial breeders, and animal shelter licenses. The measure requires ODAFF to utilize this additional fee revenue to enforce the Commercial Pet Breeders and Animal Shelter Licensing Act, with any additional leftover funds allocated for various animal care programs and services. Per ODAFF, this measure will have no fiscal impact on the agency.
