HB 4058 allows directs Service Oklahoma to allow an applicant for a driver license or identification card an option to include blood type on the license or identification card.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 4058 would amend driver license and identification card application provisions to allow applicants the option to include their blood type on the credential, as administered by Service Oklahoma. The measure creates an optional data field and would likely require minor form, system, and card-layout updates but does not create a new state program or substantially increase administrative workload. Any implementation costs are expected to be minimal and absorbable within existing budgetary resources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
