**Research Analysis**

HB 4092, as introduced, requires the State of Oklahoma to designate the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services the department with primary oversight over suicide prevention and crisis service activities as well as coordination with designated 988 Lifeline Crisis Centers to provide services to individuals accessing the 988 Mental Health Lifeline program from any jurisdiction in Oklahoma. The designated 988 Lifeline Crisis Centers must meet 988 Lifeline Program requirements and best practices guidelines. The Department must make rules and regulations to allow for appropriate information sharing and communication between and across crisis and emergency response systems as well as active collaborations and coordination of service linkages. Technology must be used to enhance communication and coordination in the delivery of behavioral health crisis services, and for data collection, analysis, and sharing.

The State of Oklahoma must establish a statewide 988 Trust Fund, to be created and administered by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, to create and maintain a statewide 988 Lifeline system and to support or enhance 988 services. The State of Oklahoma is required to implement strategies to ensure that the behavioral health crisis service system is adequately funded.
