Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 4095 designates that the Oklahoma 2-1-1 Collaborative is the lead entity for 2-1-1 call centers in the state that are providing hotline services that include support for food, housing, clothing, transportation, and medical needs. The pcs changes the membership of the Oklahoma 2-1-1 Collaborative from 15 to nine members, three from the public sector and six from the private sector. The measure provides for the membership appointments and staggers initial term lengths of members, who will thereafter serve three-year terms and may be reappointed.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 4095 reduces the Oklahoma 2-1-1 Collaborative from 15 to 9 members. Members serve without compensation but may receive expense reimbursements. Any savings to the state from fewer reimbursements are expected to be minimal, if any.
