Fiscal Analysis

The CS to HB4105 clarifies the definition of security guard under the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act by exempting certain persons contracted as ushers, ticket agents, gate agents, credential verification agents, or similar roles at events from the security guard licensing requirements when operating unarmed. In its current form, this measure is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
