Research Analysis

HB 4105 excludes from the definition of "security guard" any person contracted as an usher queue agent, ticket agent, gate agent, credential verification agent, or similar role. Contracted employees posted at venue entry points must be under the supervision of a CLEET-certified security guard or law enforcement officer. The measure requires there be one CLEET-certified security guard or law enforcement officer for every fifteen uncertified contractors at a given entry point.
