**Research Analysis**

The subcommittee substitute to HB 4112 directs several fees collected in criminal cases to remitted to the General Revenue Fund. These fees include:

- Laboratory Analysis Fee collected for forensic science services;
- DNA sample fee;
- Fingerprinting fee; and
- Forensic Science Improvement Assessment.

The measure provides that any unpaid balance of any fee assessed for the costs of prosecution previously payable to the district attorney and owed by a defendant in his or her criminal case is to be waived and deemed unenforceable and uncollectible. The measure removes the District Attorney probation supervision fee.
