Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 4117 adds that a *family resource center* also integrates access to supportive employment services.

HB 4117, as introduced, adds a definition of family resource center to Title 25, Definitions and General Provisions, which means a community, school, or faith-based hub of family support services. The centers also do the following:

- Use a multi-generational, strengths-based, family centered approach;
- Reflect and is responsive to community needs and interests;
- Provides low to no cost support; and
- Builds peer support communities for families.
