Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 4124 provides that ivermectin suitable for human use that is Food and Drug Administration approved may be sold or purchased as an over-the-counter medication without a prescription or consultation with a health care professional. A pharmacy is not criminally or civilly liable for supplying ivermectin in accordance with the measure, notwithstanding any other law.
