**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB4124 provides that notwithstanding any law to the contrary, ivermectin suitable for human use may be sold or purchased as an over-the-counter medication in Oklahoma without a prescription or consultation with a health care professional. Notwithstanding any other law, a pharmacy is not criminally or civilly liable for supplying ivermectin.

**Fiscal Analysis**
