**Research Analysis**

As introduced, HB 4128, provides that black bear and deer seasons run concurrent muzzleloader periods. Additionally, an archery period shall start no later than September 15 of each year and run through deer season.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 4128 adds a stipulation for a muzzleloader period and an archery period that runs concurrent with the appropriate deer season for the hunting of mountain lions and black bears. Upon review, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
