**Fiscal Analysis**

The CS to HB4130 expands the scope of existing gambling crimes to include online casino games and specifies additional types of providers and suppliers subject to the gambling prohibition. The measure maintains the existing penalty structure of a Class C2 felony with fines between \$500 and \$2,000. Any resulting change to the revenues collected by the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) or change in the costs incurred by the Department of Corrections (DOC) are expected to be immaterial and/or absorbed by the agencies. Therefore, this measure in its current form is anticipated to be budget neutral.
