Research Analysis

HB 4200, as introduced, removes language regarding immediate threats from the definition of "person requiring treatment." The measure also removes the language stating that a person who is homeless doesn't meet the definition of "person requiring treatment" or an "assisted outpatient" unless they meet other criteria. The measure also amends the definition of "assisted outpatient" to expand the definition to include a person who has a history of lack of compliance with mental health treatment for mental illness that has, prior to the filing of the petition, resulted in one or more acts or threats of serious violent behavior or serious physical harm to self or others within the last 36 months, changed from 24 months.
