Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB4215 updates the Filmed in Oklahoma Act of 2021 by creating a lower minimum expenditure threshold of \$20,000 for projects filmed outside of the state. Current law requires projects to have minimum expenditures of at least \$50,000 regardless of where filming takes place.
