Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 4129 requires certain energy facilities to be situated at least 500 feet from property lines. These facilities must have adequate funding for operations and infrastructure, and they must also establish a fund for the removal of obsolete materials.

A facility is subject to these requirements if it conducts carbon-related activities or if it falls into any of the following North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes:

- NAICS 221115, relating to wind electric power generation;
- NAICS 221121, relating to electric bulk power transmission and control for wind energy transmission;
- NAICS 423930 or 562920, relating to recyclable material merchants and materials recovery facilities for wind turbine component recycling or decommissioning;
- NAICS 518210, relating to data processing, hosting, and computing infrastructure providers for a large-scale data center; or
- NAICS 221122, relating to grid-scale battery storage installations.
