**Research Analysis**

The Policy Committee Recommendation to HB 4227 provides that any settlement agreement that conceals the details relating to a claim of child sexual abuse or child sexual exploitation is void and unenforceable. Only identifying information concerning a victim of child sexual abuse is to be maintained as confidential. The measure provides that prosecutions for sexual crimes against children may be commenced at any time after the commission of the offense.
