**Research Analysis**

HB 4284, as introduced, creates the Oklahoma Animal Abuse Offender Registry Act. This measure creates a registry of persons convicted of violating specified animal abuse crimes. This measure requires the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) to maintain the registry. The registry is required to include the following:

- Name and date of the person;
- Date of birth of the person;
- Offense which made the person eligible for inclusion in the registry;
- Date of conviction and type of plea;
- County where offense or offenses occurred; and
- Other identifying information deemed necessary by the OSBI to properly identify the person.

All district court clerks must forward an electronic copy of the judgement and sentence relating to the disposition of the animal abuse criminal case to the OSBI within thirty (30) days of the date of final disposition of the case. Prior to November 1, 2027 the OSBI must maintain an animal abuse offender registry website for public viewing. This measure also prescribes fines and punishments for first time and repeat offenders.
