Research Analysis

The amendment to the pcs for HB4285 removes the emergency and changes the effective date to November 1, 2026.

HB 4285 creates the "Perinatal Quality Improvement Revolving Fund" for the State Department of Health. Monies accruing in the fund are appropriated and may be budgeted and expended for the purpose of working collaboratively with quality improvement initiatives and entities operating in or founded in the state by reducing preventable newborn to infant morbidity and mortality, reducing preventable maternal morbidity and mortality, and improving maternal safety and overall outcomes.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 4285 creates the Perinatal Quality Improvement Revolving Fund Revolving Fund within the State Department of Health (OSDH) to support initiatives that improve maternal safety and perinatal health outcomes.

However, such efforts are dependent on available funds, and HB 4285 does not appropriate any money to the Fund. As a result, this measure currently has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
