**Research Analysis**

HB 4285, as introduced, creates the "Perinatal Quality Improvement Revolving Fund," which will consist all money received by the State Department of Health from any private or public source designated for the purpose of reducing preventable newborn to infant morbidity and mortality, reducing preventable maternal morbidity and mortality, and improving maternal safety and overall outcomes.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 4285 creates the Perinatal Quality Improvement Revolving Fund Revolving Fund within the State Department of Health (OSDH) to support initiatives that improve maternal safety and perinatal health outcomes.

However, such efforts are dependent on available funds, and HB 4285 does not appropriate any money to the Fund. As a result, this measure currently has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
