Research Analysis

HB 4300, as introduced, removes the exception of resubmitting fingerprints for a criminal history records search under the Oklahoma Child Care Facilities Licensing Act that individuals must obtain not less than once every five years.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 4300 removes language that exempts individuals from resubmitting fingerprints during routine criminal history checks, which are required at least once every five (5) years under the Oklahoma Child Care Facilities Licensing Act. Any additional costs or fees are expected to be covered by the individual or facility; therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
