HB 4303 as introduced, extends the notification window for publishing municipal ordinances from 15 days to 30 days after passage.

**Fiscal Analysis**

House Bill 4303 amends statutory language to lengthen the publication requirement for certain municipal notices from fifteen to thirty days after passage. The measure deals exclusively with procedural requirements at the local municipal level of government. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
