**Research Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation for HB 4336 clarifies the violations for administering unauthorized pain management treatments. A physician practicing interventional pain management without the appropriate license violates either the Oklahoma Allopathic and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act or the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act and may face disciplinary actions that could include license revocation. Similarly, a nurse who engages in interventional pain management without proper supervision is violating the Nursing Practice Act and is subject to discipline that could also lead to license revocation.
