Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 4392 creates the Sustainable Emerging Aviation Services Investment Program (SEA SIP). The Oklahoma Department of Aerospace and Aeronautics must designate at least five sites as Advanced Air Mobility Pilot Sites within the state. If such sites meet specified guidelines they will be subject to support and regulatory assistance from the Department. Additionally, the Department can provide funding opportunities for infrastructure, equipment, software, or other needs. The Department will retain ownership of any asset it invests in.

Lastly, the measure creates the Sustainable Emerging Aviation Services Investment Program (SEA SIP) Revolving Fund. The fund will be made up of federal and state grants or appropriations, private donations, and revenues or fees recouped from assets in which the Department invests.
