**Research Analysis**

HB 4412, as introduced, creates a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Health Care Authority that will be designated the "ADvantage Waiver Home and Community-based Services for Seniors Revolving Fund." The fund will consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services designated for this fund. The funds will be used for the purpose of providing home and community-based services to persons at risk of placement in a nursing facility who elect to be served in a home and community-based setting instead.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 4412 creates the ADvantage Waiver Home and Community-based Services for Seniors Revolving Fund for the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) to provide home and community-based services to those at risk of placement in a nursing facility but prefer to receive services in a home and community-based setting. HB 4412 does not appropriate any money to the Fund. As a result, the measure currently has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
