**Research Analysis**

HB 4414, as introduced, requires the Oklahoma Housing Finance Agency (OHFA) to create, use, and maintain a community housing needs assessment tool to allocate funds. Additionally, OHFA is required to work with the Legislature Workforce Housing Committee to administer and improve housing accessibility statewide.
