Research Analysis

HB 4423, as introduced, requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to verify the immigration status of all applicants to all of their programs using the federal Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) system. Upon final determination that an applicant's SAVE status indicates the person is not lawfully in the United States, the Authority must notify the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Agency of the applicant's unverifiable legal presence in the United States. For any application for child-only Medicaid benefits, the Authority must also verify the immigration status of the qualified adult applying on their behalf, regardless if they are included as a beneficiary or applicant for assistance. Upon final determination that the qualified adult's results do not indicate that the person is lawfully in the United States, the Authority will notify ICE.
