Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 4430 adds that an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse who is employed by a state agency or facility that is covered by or subject to the Governmental Tort Claims Act will be deemed in compliance with malpractice insurance requirements when practicing under state employment. If the Advanced Practice Registered Nurse practices outside of such state employment, they must comply with malpractice insurance requirements.

HB 4430 provides that a physician assistant employed by a state agency or a facility covered by the Governmental Tort Claims Act will be deemed compliant with malpractice insurance requirements when under state employment. However, if practicing outside of state employment, they must comply with malpractice insurance requirements.
