**Research Analysis**

HB 4431, as introduced, provides that an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse employed by a state agency or a facility covered by the Governmental Tort Claims Act will be deemed compliant with malpractice insurance requirements when under state employment. However, if practicing outside of state employment, they must comply with malpractice insurance requirements.
