Fiscal Analysis

HJR 1011 amends Article 6 of the Oklahoma Constitution by adding a new Section 36. The measure directs the Oklahoma Legislature to create an election recall process for statewide election officials. After communication with the Oklahoma State Election Board (SEB), a special election pursuant to the measure would cost approximately \$2,100,000.

Notably, this the maximum estimation for a range of 0\$ to \$2,100,000. For instance, if such election is conducted in conjunction with a statutory statewide election, a different fiscal impact would be realized where only a need for an additional ballot page for inclusion of the question arises. However, it may also be noted that there are instances where no such election is necessary, in which case the measure would have no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations. Therefore, the fiscal impact provided is indicative of a per election basis, rather than an annual state budget estimate.
