Research Analysis

The Committee Substitute to HJR 1035 approves all proposed permanent rules filed on or before February 1, 2025 of the following agencies:

Commission on Children and Youth;
State Department of Health;
Department of Human Services;
State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision;
Board of Medicolegal Investigations;
State Board of Osteopathic Examiners;
State Board of Examiners of Perfusionists;
Health Care Workforce Training Commission; and
Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Commission.

All proposed permanent rules of the Oklahoma Funeral Board filed on or before February 1, 2025, are hereby approved, except for the proposed changes to paragraph (6) of OAC 235:10-3-2 and the proposed changes in the entirety of OAC 235:10-3-4; and the proposed changes in paragraphs (c) and (e) of OAC 235:10-14-1.

All proposed permanent rules of the Oklahoma Board of Chiropractic Examiners filed on or before February 1, 2025, are hereby approved, except for the proposed changes in OAC 140:15-5-5.

All proposed permanent rules of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority filed on or before February 1, 2025, are hereby approved, except for the proposed changes in division (GG) of subparagraph (1) of paragraph (a) of OAC 317:30-5-2.

All proposed permanent rules of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services filed on or before February 1, 2025, are hereby approved, except for: the proposed changes to the "diversion control plan" and "medical director" definitions of OAC 450:70-1-2; the proposed changes to subparagraphs (2), (4), (6), and (9) of paragraph (a) of OAC 450:70-4-8.3; the proposed changes to subparagraph (3) of paragraph (c) of OAC 450:70-6-10; and the proposed changes to paragraph (b) of OAC 450:70-6-17.2.
