Research Analysis

HJR 1040 would send to a vote of the people a Constitutional Amendment to Section 1, Article VII requiring the courts of Oklahoma to uphold and adhere to the law as provided in the United States Constitution, the Oklahoma Constitution, the United States Code, federal regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, established common law, the Oklahoma Statutes and rules, and if necessary the law of another state of the United States provided the law of the other state does not include Sharia law, in making judicial decisions. Courts are not to look to the legal precepts of other nations or cultures. Specifically, the courts are not to consider international law or Sharia law.
