Research Analysis

HJR 1050, as introduced, decreases the TSET Board of Directors's terms from seven years to four years, and subjects such Board members to at will removal by their appointing authority.

Fiscal Analysis

HJR 1050 proposes an amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution to decrease the term limit for members of the Board of Directors of the Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust Fund (TSET) from seven years to four years and to allow their appointing authority to remove them at will. The Board of Directors is responsible for directing earnings from the state's tobacco settlement endowment to programs that promote health and well-being across the state. Therefore, shortening board members' terms may impact the distribution of these funds.
