**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HJR 1084 would send to a vote of the people a Constitutional Amendment to Section 1, Article VII prohibiting a court, the state, or any political subdivision, board, agency, or commission created by the Constitution or established by statute from recognizing or enforcing any religious code, body of law, or practice that is repugnant to, incompatible with, or that does not recognize and protect the same or equivalent individual rights and liberties guaranteed under the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma or the Constitution of the United States of America.
