**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB 1014 requires counties, cities, local governmental entities, and public trusts with a county or municipality as its sole beneficiary to provide for a local bid preference of not more than five percent when awarding public construction contracts exceeding \$100,000 or construction management trade contracts exceeding \$50,000.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Engrossed SB 1014 modifies statutory language to require certain local bidding preferences rather than merely permitting such preferences. However, the five percent local bid preference cap remains. The measure deals exclusively with local county level bidding procedures and does not mandate any action or expenditure by a state agency. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
