**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute to SB 1024 prohibits the adoption of a proposed rule by an agency unless the agency receives express written approval from the Governor or appropriate cabinet secretary. The measure requires a rule impact statement to include an analysis of alternatives to adopting the proposed rule; estimates of the amount of time that would be spent by state employees to develop the rule and the amount of other resources that would be utilized to develop the rule; and a summary and preliminary comparison of any existing or proposed federal regulations that are intended to address the activities to be regulated by the proposed rule.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to SB 1024 prescribes requirements towards state agencies seeking to promulgate or amend emergency or permanent rules.
