Research Analysis

CCR A to SB1039 provides that a medical marijuana patient license application is rejected for failure to provide required information that the applicant will have 30 days to submit the required information for reconsideration. The measure also provides that OMMA notifies applicants for transporter licenses, initial dispensary licenses, initial processor licenses, or laboratory licenses in the same method and manner as the application was submitted. The measure also requires that all applicants and licensees remit all required license and application fees in full within 45 days of notification by the Authority. Failure to remit such fees will result in the denial of the application. This applies to applicants for transporter licenses, initial dispensary licenses, initial processor licenses, or laboratory licenses as well as all medical marijuana business, medical marijuana research facility, medical marijuana education facility and medical marijuana waste disposal facility licensees.

Fiscal Analysis

The CCR A to SB 1039 establishes specific time limits for the resubmission of incomplete medical marijuana applications and outlines the conditions under which the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) is authorized to deny an applicant's application. In its current form, SB 1039 is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
