Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 1039 provides that medical marijuana patient application may only be rejected or denied based on the applicant not meeting standards set forth, completing the application improperly, not paying license or application fees, or for a reason provided for in the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act and in statute. If an application is rejected because required information was not provided, the applicant will have 30 days to submit the required information for reconsideration. Unless determined otherwise, a resubmitted application with errors or omissions not clerical will be denied. The Authority will also deny any application that has submitted more than once with any errors or omissions not clerical or typographical in nature. The measure also provides that a lack of certificate of occupancy will not be the sole cause of the denial of a application for a medical marijuana business application. Additionally, a medical marijuana business application that has been submitted more than once with non-clerical errors or omissions will be denied.
