Research Analysis

The committee substitute for SB 105 modifies the requirements for students to qualify for the Lindsey Nicole Henry Scholarship. The measure:

- Removes the requirement for a student to have attended a public school prior to applying for the scholarship;
- Removes the word "disability" and replaces it with the phrase "special need";
- Allows all children who have moved to Oklahoma due to a military change of station orders to qualify;
- Removes language stating that acceptance of a scholarship has the same effect as parental revocation of consent to services under certain provisions of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
