Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 1067 authorizes a local government entity or ambulance service provider acting on its behalf to annually submit ambulance service rates set by the local government to the Insurance Department. The Department must establish and maintain a public database with all the submitted rates. The minimum allowable rate must be the least of the submitted rates, 275% of the current published rate as established by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, or the ambulance service provider's billed charges.

Fiscal Analysis

According to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA), this measure is still under review to see if there is a fiscal impact.

According to the Oklahoma Insurance Department (OID) there will be an impact to the agency as it will need to create a new database to implement this measure and will likely have to go out to bid for an IT vendor to do so. As OID has not done so yet, it is unsure of the potential cost. OID is a non-appropriated state agency though, therefore the creation of the database should not create a fiscal impact to the state budget.
