## **Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 1076 increases the maximum gross annual payroll limit for agriculture, ranching, and horticulture employers from \$100,000 to \$150,000 before their workers are counted as employees under the Administrative Workers' Compensation Act. The measure also exempts children working on a farm, ranch, livestock market, or other agricultural businesses owned by their parents from being classified as employees under this act.
