The committee substitute to SB 1091 allows a campus police officer to serve as an elected member of the governing board of a municipality if that municipality is outside of the municipal boundaries where they serve as a campus police officer.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to SB 1091 permits campus police officer elections to municipal governing boards where such municipalities are outside of the officer's professional municipal jurisdiction.
