Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 112 recategorizes plumbing licensees into residential journeyman plumbers, residential plumbing contractors, unlimited journeyman plumbers, and unlimited plumbing contractors.

Applicants for a residential journeyman plumber license must be at least 18 years old and have either three years of experience under a licensed plumbing contractor, two years of experience with written approval from a supervising contractor, 1,000 plumbing education classroom hours and 2,000 hours of work experience, two years of plumbing experience in the military, or possession of an equivalent out-of-state license with residency in Oklahoma. For an unlimited journeyman plumber license, an applicant must meet similar criteria, with the option of three years of military experience instead of two. Both residential and unlimited journeyman plumber licenses may be issued for three years.

Applicants for a residential or unlimited plumbing contractor license must be at least 18 years old, have at least one year of experience as a licensed residential journeyman plumber, and have either 1,000 plumbing education classroom hours and 4,000 hours of work experience, two years of plumbing experience in the military, or an equivalent out-of-state contractor license with Oklahoma residency.
