## **Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute to SB 1135 provides that the premium taxes to be deposited in the Medicaid Health Improvement Revolving Fund for the calendar year ending December 31, 2024, and for each calendar year thereafter, are not subject to the apportionment pursuant to Section 312.1 of Title 36. The measure provides that the tax credits provided for Foreign and Alien Insurers are not available to a contracted entity.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1135 provides that premium tax revenues deposited into the Medicaid Health Improvement Fund for the calendar year ending December 31, 2024 and for each year thereafter, shall not be subject to certain apportionments. The fiscal impact will depend on the revenue collected each year, however, an increase in the Fund balance is anticipated.
