**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute to SB 1136 directs the apportionment of funds provided to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority. The measure directs that \$100,031,677.00 to be used for program growth and to replace funding no longer available due to the reduction of federal matching funds. The measure provides duties and compensation of employees of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority are to be set by the Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority. The measure authorizes the transfer of funds to facilitate cash management of federal grants and disbursements.

**Fiscal Analysis**

From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) in Enrolled House Bill 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, One Hundred Million Thirty-one Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$100,031,677) is to be used for program growth and to replace funding no longer available due to the reduction of federal matching dollars.

Additionally, the measure directs the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to transfer funds between the OHCA federal and revolving funds in amounts requested by OHCA.
